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Interview with Rohan Passmore Fascinating Canefire facts

The Canefire Gazette sat down with founder Rohan Passmore and learned some tasty tidbits about the company's early days.

- He didn't name the business the Kimberley Rum Company because he liked the sound of the name. The company was founded in Kununurra in the Kimberley in 1998.
- 2. The first bottle of Canefire Rum was distilled, entered in a competition (winning second prize), auctioned (for \$200) and drank within 48 hours.
- 3. When they were granted a licence in 2001 they were the only licensed distiller in WA.

Until the mill closure in 2007, Canefire was produced with sugar from the Kununurra sugar mill

Vietnam is stepping forward with a lot of white spirit production, particularly

If you have ever had the misfortune of finding a dead rat in a damp area – that smell is how snake whisky tastes, and the taste lingers. The Whisky was smooth, I have to give it credit there, but that musty, decayed after taste will haunt

me to my grave. There were two other spirits on offer - Tiger Penis Whisky and Turtle Whisky. I refused both. Tigers are too majestic to kill so frivolously and turtles are too adorable to pickle and drink.

Lovers of craft spirits need to keep an eye on Asia. Their approach is unique and inventive. This experience will bring some perspective to help us at Canefire continue to come up with quality spirits.
